This proposition would permit the use of said funds to acquire other medical equipment, supplies and to pay for training of personnel for the ambulance, in addition to the sinking fund for the purchase and equipping of one or more replacement ambulances. A vote against this proposition will continue the current additional property tax of \$.01 per \$100 that was authorized by the voters by special election on August 11, 2015 limited in use for the purchase and equipping of one or more replacement ambulances for the Rock County Ambulance.</p>
