

The Rock County Board of Commissioners met at 7:00 a.m. at the county road shop as advertised. Present were commissioners Jim Stout and Stan Larson and road employees Darrell Olson, road foreman; Jeff Kinney, Waylon Reynolds, Josh Montgomery, Garrett Weidner and Mike Turpin. Discussed road matters. Meeting adjourned at 8:00 a.m.

The Rock County Board of Commissioners met at 10:00 a.m. as advertised. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Craven at 10:08 a.m. Roll call was taken. Present were Stout, Larson and Craven. Also present was Joyce Stahl, County Clerk.

The minutes of the March 5, 2018 regular meeting were presented. Motion made by Stout and seconded by Larson to approve minutes as presented. Motion carried.

The agenda for the day was reviewed. Motion made by Stout and seconded by Larson to approve the agenda as posted in the Clerk's office. Motion carried.

Chairman Craven stated the Open Meetings Act is posted in the commissioners meeting room as required.

Commissioners approved County Clerk and Clerk of the District Court fees for February, 2018.

Kathleen Sybrant met with the commissioners in regard to EMT matters. Two radios are needed for the new EMTS at a cost of approximately \$1100/1200 for both. Motion made by Stout and seconded by Larson authorizing Kathleen to purchase said radios. Roll call vote taken. Stout: Yes Larson: Yes Craven: Yes Motion carried.

Stacey Knox, representing Rock/Bassett Chamber of Commerce, met with the commissioners in regard to dumpsters for Clean-Up Day in May. Motion made by Stout and seconded by Larson that Rock County will pay 60% of the dumpster rent for Clean-Up Day. Motion carried.

Mona Davis, County Treasurer, presented list of delinquent real estate taxes that were offered for sale and purchased by various investors at the Rock County Public Tax Sale on Monday, March 5, 2018 for their information.

Commissioners authorized County Clerk to contact County Attorney to prepare a notification to Nebraska Machinery Company (CAT) that commissioners propose to raise renting of facilities in the Rock County Road Shop to \$500 per month but are willing to negotiate.

Motion made by Craven and seconded by Stout to rescind motion to approve adding the ballot issue that clarifies the current special election levy to the Primary Election ballot in May for the Rock County Hospital made at the March 5, 2018 regular meeting due to the fact that certification was received at the County Clerk's office after the filing deadline. Roll call vote taken. Stout: Yes Larson: Yes Craven: Yes Motion carried.

Motion made by Larson and seconded by Stout to go into Board of Equalization meeting at 11:22 a.m. Motion carried. Appearing at this time was Monica Turpin, Assessor. Motion made by Stout and seconded by Larson to approve change to parcel #750002528. Motion carried. Turpin brought to the attention of commissioners that furnace in the weed shed is not working properly. Commissioners advised repairs and improvements would be made to the shed this summer.
