

The Rock County Board of Commissioners met at 7:00 a.m. at the county road shop as advertised. Present were commissioners Jim Stout, Dustin Craven and Stan Larson and road employees Darrell Olson, road foreman; Josh Montgomery, Waylon Reynolds, and Mike Turpin Also present was Glen May, commissioner candidate. Discussed road matters. Meeting adjourned at 8:00 a.m.

The Rock County Board of Commissioners met at 10:00 a.m. as advertised. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Craven at 10:00 a.m. Roll call was taken. Present were Stout, Larson and Craven. Also present were Joyce Stahl, County Clerk and Glen May, commissioner candidate.

The minutes of the August 20, 2018 regular meeting were presented. Motion made by Stout and seconded by Larson to approve minutes as presented. Motion carried.

The agenda for the day was reviewed. Motion made by Stout and seconded by Larson to approve the agenda as posted in the Clerk's office. Motion carried.

Chairman Craven stated the Open Meetings Act is posted in the commissioners meeting room as required.

Rod Stolpart, Weed Supt, met with the commissioners to advise them of the repairs done on the pickup used for road side spraying while he was out of town with it. Commissioners stated these repairs would be taken out of the Road fund.

Erica Teel, Librarian and Kim Ost, Asst Librarian met with the commissioners to give them update on bookmobile matter. Teel stated a public meeting was held with their regular library meeting on August 29, 2018. They felt it was well attended. She advised bookmobile was titled under the name of Rock County Public Library. The library board voted to rescind their motion to terminate bookmobile services and voted to operate the bookmobile for the 2018/2019 school year. At the end of the school year, bookmobile will be sold.

Motion made by Craven and seconded by Stout to go into Board of Equalization meeting at 10:28 a.m. Motion carried. Appearing at this time was Monica Turpin, Assessor and Mona Davis, Treasurer. Motion made by Stout and seconded by Craven to correct May 21, 2018 minutes in regard to correction of parcel no. 000000052 which should have been parcel no. 000000502. Motion carried. They also discussed parcel no. 750002297, irrigated land vs dry land. They are waiting for more information from the county attorney. Commissioners went back into regular meeting at 10:56 a.m.

Commissioners discussed NIRMA contact person for the county. As of January 1, 2019, NIRMA contact person duties will be transferred from the Assessor's office to the Clerk's office.

Tim Gragert, candidate for Legislature of District #40, visited with the commissioners.

Commissioners discussed applications received for the road department position. Three applications were received. Appearing at this time was Darrell Olson, road foreman. Motion made by Stout and seconded by Craven to offer position to Greg Swan at beginning salary of \$15.00 per hour, six month probation period. Roll call vote taken. Stout: Yes Larson: Yes Craven: Yes Motion carried.

Daunitta Buoy, payroll clerk, discussed part-time employee benefits with the commissioners.

Motion made by Stout and seconded by Larson to approve sheriff fees for August, 2018. Motion carried.

Motion made by Stout and seconded by Larson to pay for 2016 CAT backhoe, purchased in August, out of the Inheritance Fund and Inheritance Fund to be reimbursed. Motion carried.
